In order to ensure the coop's boycott policies are consistent with the desires of the majority of its members, any reduction of the 75% supermajority threshold (currently enshrined in the Guide to the General and Annual Meetings) should require a 75% supermajority vote at the GM, rather than just a majority vote (the default standard for most votes taken at the GM, including votes to amend the Guide).
